

**City of Midway City Council Regular Meeting
Monday, May 17, 2021, 5:30 p.m.**

The regular meeting of the Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Grayson Vandegrift and the following Council Members were present: Kaye Nita Gallagher, Sara Hicks, Logan Nance, Mary Raglin, Steve Simoff, and Stacy Thurman. Also present were City Attorney Sharon Gold, City Clerk Cindy Foster, Asst. Police Chief Rob Young.

New Business

Guests Bob and Steven King spoke to the Council about a fundraiser for Allen Vann. Council Member Thurman made a motion to accept a permit for the Allen Vann fundraiser on June 26th; Council Member Gallagher seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried 6-0. The City will help with porta potties if needed.

Council Member Nance made a motion to accept a permit for Juneteenth Celebration on June 19th and to close the north half of Main Street between 11 am and 9 pm; Council Member Hicks seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Hicks made a motion to accept a permit for a Remembrance Walk on July 31st; Council Member Raglin seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried 6-0.

The City Council discussed policies for food trucks. Permits will be reviewed on a case by case basis until a policy and ordinance are in place.

Mayor Vandegrift informed the Council that there was one bid for the jetter trailer from Buchanan Contracting for \$7,000.00. Council Member Nance made a motion to accept the bid; Council Member Hicks seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried 6-0.
