In order to have a name considered for eligibility to be added to the Veterans Memorial a candidate must fit one of the following categories. Be a resident of Midway while actively serving in the US Armed Forces, Be a Veteran who is buried in Midway or Be a Veteran who was born in Midway.

April 21, 1898, through July 4, 1902. If the veteran served with the U.S. military forces Engaged in hostilities in the Moro Province, the ending date is July 15, 1903. (Spanish-American)

April 6, 1917 to Nov. 11, 1918 (World War I), Dec. 7, 1941 to Dec. 31, 1946 (World War II)

June 27, 1950 to Jan. 31, 1955 (Korean War), Feb. 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975 (Vietnam War)

Aug. 24, 1982 to July 31, 1984 (Lebanon / Grenada), Dec. 20, 1989 to Jan. 31, 1990 (Panama)

Aug. 2, 1990 to today (Gulf War / War On Terrorism)
