

**City of Midway City Council Regular Meeting
Tuesday, July 6, 2021, 5:30 p.m.**

The regular meeting of the Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Grayson Vandegrift and the following Council Members were present: Kaye Nita Gallagher, Sara Hicks, Stacy Thurman and Steve Simoff. Approval of Minutes

New Business

Encroachment Permit – Greathouse Pumpkin Wagon. Motion for approval by Council Member Simoff, seconded by Council Member Hicks. Motion Carried 4-0.

Event Permit – Midway Merchant’s Association – August 20th for a Community Block Party. Motion for approval by Council Member Hicks, seconded by Council Member Thurman. Motion carried 4-0.

Chuck Strader Production Rep. – Toyota Commercial. Alan Forbes attended meeting regarding commercial. Motion to close North side of E Main St from 7:00am to 12:00pm for filming the commercial by Council Member Hicks, seconded by Council Member Thurman. Motion carried 4-0.

Old Business

Sewer Project – Sewer Main trunk line at Cypress Creek Farm is now completed. The line was a 12” main and it was replaced with a 15” main. Mayor Vandegrift mentioned that he would like to get a survey of town which would be anonymous to find more information as to how many sump pumps may be putting water into the sewer system rather than the storm sewer system. More information to come later on that project.

Freeny Land Creek Access – Mr. Freeny will come before the Council next meeting to officially present land to the City for future use to access Elkhorn Creek.
