

**City of Midway City Council Regular Meeting
Monday, February 21, 2022, 5:30 p.m.**

The regular meeting of the Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Grayson Vandegrift via teleconference, and the following Council Members were present: Kaye Nita Gallagher, Sara Hicks, Logan Nance, Mary Raglin, Steve Simoff and Stacy Thurman. Also present were City Attorney Sharon Gold, City Clerk Cindy Foster, Versailles Police, Woodford Sun, and guests Cortney Neikirk and Mary Weese.

New Business

Cortney Neikirk from the Midway Business Association presented an event permit application for a Community Block Party on 5/28/2022 from 4:00 – 10:00 pm and a request to block off the north side of Main Street. Council Member Simoff made a motion to accept; Council Member Nance seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed 6-0.

Cortney Neikirk from the Midway Business Association presented an event permit application for the Midway Fall Festival 9/16/2022 at 7:00 am until 7:00 pm on 9/18/2022 and a request to block off both sides of Main Street. Council Member Hicks made a motion to accept; Council Member Thurman seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed 6-0.

Mary Weese from Northside Elementary PTO talked about a 5K fundraising event the PTO is holding on May 15th to raise funds to purchase shade for the school playground. Council Member Nance made a motion for the City to donate \$1,000,00 for a "Title" sponsorship; Council Member Gallagher seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed 6-0.

Mayor Vandegrift discussed a new Veteran's Monument Committee. He appointed Council Member Raglin as the Chair and Council Members Nance and Hicks as members. The Committee will vote on names to be added to the monument.

Old Business

The Commission discussed the request for a designated parking space by Milam House that was tabled at the February 7th meeting. The question died due to lack of a motion.

Council Member Hicks requested to hear Resolution 2022-002, A Resolution to Surplus Fire Department Items. Mayor Vandegrift presented the reading. Council Member Raglin made a motion to accept; Council Member Thurman seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed 6-0.

The next meeting scheduled for March 7th will be held live at City Hall, 101 East Main Street.

City of Midway administrative offices officially moved to 426 South Winter Street on February 21, 2022.
