

**City of Midway City Council Regular Meeting
Monday, February 6, 2023, 5:30pm**

The regular meeting of Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Thurman. The following Council Members were present: Patrick Hall, Logan Nance, Sara Hicks, Mary Raglin, Kaye Nita Gallagher, Dee Mason. Also present were City Clerk Elizabeth Waterfill, Versailles Asst. Police Chief Rob Young, Woodford Sun representatives Scott White and Ali Cetinok. Absent: Sharon Gold Legal Representative.

Moment of Reflection – Mayor Thurman asked that everyone pause for a moment of silence.

Approval of Minutes –

January 3, 2023 – Council Member Hall noticed that the minutes did not report his name present at the meeting. With assumption of the needed correction, minutes were approved by council member Nance; seconded by Mason. All six council members voted to approve.

January 17, 2023 – Council member Nance made 1st motion; Hall seconded. All six council members voted to approve.

New Business –

Heather McColl represented the non-profit Northside Elementary School PTO to request a \$1,000.00 donation to support the Thoroughbred Trot 5k Sunday, April 23, 2023 at 3pm. Council member Raglin made the first motion; Mason seconded. All six council members voted to approve.

Board of Architecture Review appointment of Debra Shockley. Gallagher made 1st motion; Nance seconded. All six members voted unanimously.

Cemetery Committee Report – Chairperson Hicks was directed to contact street supervisor Nelson Wright to assist original architect with early plantings.

City Staff Evaluations- Mayor Thurman reported that evaluations are in process.

New Employee Applications – Applications are being accepted to hire an assistant to Jack Blevins the water treatment plant manager.

Flock Cameras - Chief Rob Young was asked to elaborate on the solar powered Flock cameras that have been installed on Midway Road. He explained that the cameras will capture license plates only. The cameras will aid police by exposing offenders in hit and run accidents; stolen and damaged property; abductions, etc.

The cameras were funded by collaboration of Midway/Versailles/Woodford County governments.


