

City of Midway City Council Regular Meeting
Location: The Homeplace at Midway
Monday, May 20, 2024, 5:30pm

The regular meeting of Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Vandegrift. The following Council Members were present: Patrick Hall, Logan Nance, Mary Raglin, Kaye Nita Gallagher, Dee Mason. Sara Hicks was also absent from the meeting until 6:12pm.

Moment of Reflection – Mayor Vandegrift asked for a moment of silence. Council member Dee Mason reported that a past resident, Keith Booth, passed.

New Business –

- Resolution 2024-003: Honoring the service of former mayor Stacy Thurman – Council member Patrick Hall made a motion to read the resolution to adopt Friday, May 24, 2024 as “Stacy Thurman Day” in Midway, Kentucky. Council member Raglin made a first motion to approve; council member Mason made a second motion; All approved 5-0
- Midway Parks Board-Budget Request Presentation -Midway Park Manager, Jeremy Devine shared with council park happenings over the past 12 months. Midway Park Board President, Cecelia Gass, presented the council members with forecasted expenses to maintain the parks. The total is: \$31,830.00. Mayor Vandegrift assured the Parks Board that the submission will be considered during the upcoming budget workshops and voted upon by June 30, 2024.
- Mary Lynn Spalding, President and CEO, Christian Care Communities updated the council members on Phase 2 of The Homeplace at Midway.
- Bid recommendation on city street paving was presented to the council by Mayor Vandegrift. Council vote to accept the lowest bid upon recommendation of the city’s engineer David Brown with HMB. Council member Nance made first motion to approve; Mason made a second motion; All approved 5-0.
- An Encroachment permit for signage was submitted by J.W. Brown of Midway Insurance. Council member Nance made the first motion to approve hanging the sign flat to the side of the building; council member Hall made a second motion; All approved 5-0; Council member Hicks abstained from voting.
