**Regular Meeting**  
**Monday, November 4, 2024, 5:30 p.m.**

The regular meeting of Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Vandegrift. 
**Old Business**

- Ordinance 2024-008 – Ordinance Confirming the sale and awarding a nonexclusive franchise to Kentucky Utilities Corporation for a term of ten (10) years for electric franchise. Council member Hall made a motion to read the ordinance. City attorney Gold read the ordinance. Council member Hall made a first motion to accept; Nance made a second motion. Motion carried with all in favor, six (6) yay's; zero (0) nay's.

Council member Gallagher made the first motion to adjourn the meeting; Mason made a second motion. Motion carried 6-0.
