

City of Midway City Council Regular Meeting
Monday, March 3, 2025, 5:30pm

The regular meeting of Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Vandegrift. The following Council Members were present: Patrick Hall, Logan Nance, Mary Raglin, Kaye Nita Gallagher, Steve Simoff, and Ian VanSteenbergh. Also present were City Clerk Elizabeth Waterfill, Versailles Police Lieutenant Conner and EMS Crabtree.

Moment of Silence – Mayor Vandegrift asked for a moment of silence.

Approval of Minutes:

- Regular Meeting Minutes, February 3, 2025 First motion Nance/Second Hall, All in favor 6-0

New Business –

- Resolution 2025-02 A resolution to accept a low interest loan from the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority to fund a new water line. Raglin made a request to read. Mayor Vandegrift read the resolution. First motion to approve was made by Hall/Second by Nance, All in favor 6-0
- Memorandum of Understanding: GIS 911 Service. Hall made a request to read. Mayor Vandegrift read the MOU. First motion was made by VanSteenberg/Second Raglin, All in favor 6-0
- Renew Line of Credit at Stockyards Bank. The mayor explained to council members how the city may benefit from an open line of credit. The mayor recommended that he and Elizabeth Waterfill, the city clerk, sign loan documents. In addition to the mayor and city clerk, Sonya Conner, the assistant clerk, will be recognized as a signer. First motion to accept the recommendations was made by Simoff/Seconded by Raglin, All in favor 6-0
- Water Service Line Inventory Recap of a mandatory EPA letter to Midway residents explaining how the city will be in compliance before the 2027 deadline
- Barrel Tax Update – distilleries housing barrels of whiskey are taxed according to KRS 132.14-the taxing will eventually be phased out to zero.
