The regular meeting of the Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Grayson Vandegrift and the following council members were present: Kaye Nita Gallagher, John McDaniel, Steve Simoff, Bruce Southworth and Johnny Wilson. Sara Hicks was absent.

Motion by Council member John McDaniel and seconded by Council member Johnny Wilson to adopt the July 2, 2018 regular meeting minutes as written. Motion carried 5 to 0.

Amanda Hale, Director for Development for The Lexington School and Christian Juckett Attorney at Law with the Law firm of Rubin & Hayes came before the council to ask the City for Bonding Capacity to build a new building that will house the Learning Center. They will make a formal request at a later meeting.

Motion by Council member John McDaniel and seconded by Council member Steve Simoff to close North side of East Main from 5:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on July 27 and August 24, 2018 for Midsummer Nights. Motion carried 5 to 0.

Woodford County Extension Homemaker 2018 Backpack Project Funding Request was tabled.

Motion by Council member Bruce Southworth and seconded by Council member John McDaniel to cash the Certificate of Deposit at Community Trust Bank of \$285,490 and pay off the remaining debt on the new Waste Water Treatment Plant and roll the remainder left over into a new Certificate of Deposit at Community Trust Bank. The Final bill for paying off the loan is \$198,311.74. Motion carried 5 to 0


Motion by Council member Bruce Southworth and seconded by Council member Kaye Nita Gallagher to adjourn. (6:00 p.m.)
