The regular meeting of the Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Grayson Vandegrift and the following council members were present: Sara Hicks, Libby Warfield, John McDaniel, Bruce Southworth, Steve Simoff, Kaye Nita Gallagher

Motion by Council Member John McDaniel and seconded by Council Member Kaye Nita Gallagher to adopt the March 20, 2017 regular meeting minutes. Motion carried 6-0.

Locally Grown Youth Group Donation Request – Lee and Sara Busick spoke to the Council in regards to the Youth Group being a community wide multi-denominational Youth Group at the local level in Midway. They have kids from not only Midway but also from surrounding counties. They have Wednesday night Spiritual Growth meetings and Thursday night Wellness meeting each week. Their overall goal is to develop teens that are good neighbors/citizens and show kids their value to the community. Mayor Grayson Vandegrift suggested a Refreshment Sponsor for \$500.00. Motion by Council Member John McDaniel and seconded by Council Member Libby Warfield. Motion carried 6-0.

Midway Merchant President – Peggy Angel. Spoke with Council on how the Merchants Assoc. wants to work with the City to coordinate events. Saw Horse Derby for the month of April to draw more people to town.

Paul Chisholm with Lakeshore Learning Materials was recognized.

City Updates:

Walter Bradley Park website is up and running. Walterbradleypark.org There will be a Tree Planting on Earth Day at the park from 10am to 1pm. Volunteers are needed.

Water Bill Payments Online – Coming Soon. The cost will be a service fee that is passed on to the consumer.

Sidewalk Repairs – Homeowners will be working soon to get sidewalks replaced by May 31st.

Human Rights Commission Meeting at City Hall April 6 at 6:30pm.

Dept of Transportation – Weisenberger Mill Bridge. Mayor Vandegrift has spoken with the Dept. of Transportation regarding the bridge. At this time they are doing a Historical Study and an Environmental Study of the area. They do not have a timeline of completion but have said they will award the Old Bridge to the City if they go through with the project.


Next week Mayor Grayson Vandegrift will meet with John Soper and Dennis Anderson to work on a Master Plan for Midway Station.

Midway Women's Club has asked that the Council consider a waiver in the Garbage Ordinance for non-profit groups who don't produce garbage at their place of meeting. Mayor Grayson Vandegrift asked Counsel Member Sara Hicks (Chair) of the Finance, Ordinance and Policy Committee to work on that request.

Council Member Bruce Southworth asked for a motion to approve Removable Speed Humps for E. Stephens St., not to exceed a cost of \$5,500.00. Mayor Vandegrift asked if there is a liability for having speed humps. Council Member Bruce Southworth has checked and there are no statutory and regulatory authority for installation of speed humps. Attorney General #81-91, KRS 189.337 and 603 KAR 5:050. Motion by Council Member Steve Simoff to approve, also suggesting the consideration of speed humps on Main St. as well. Seconded by Council Member Libby Warfield. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Bruce Southworth motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:27pm seconded by Council Member John McDaniel. Motion carried 6-0.
